

Etiquette for safe use of the Trails System

Protect the Environment

A number of the trails pass through environmentally sensitive areas. To safeguard our natural areas please stay on the trails and give water fowl and other animals a wide berth. No motorized vehicles are allowed on the trails at any time.

Be Alert

Be sure the trail ahead is clear of obstructions such as overhanging or fallen branches, be aware of sharp bends in the trail, bridge crossings, intersections and hills. Watch for hazardous conditions or vandalisms that might be unsafe to others and report them to the City of Lacombe by calling 403-782-1266

Be Careful at Intersections

Slow down and look both ways and behind you before crossing road and trail intersections. Pedestrians always have the right of way.

Be Visible

Ensure your visibility at night by wearing light-coloured clothing with reflective tape material. Outfit your bicycle with lights and reflectors

Share the Trails

The trails were established with the intention of allowing a wide variety of user groups, including cyclists, pedestrians and joggers. All users, including those accompanied by pets on leashes, must stay to the right of the centre and use only half the width of the pathway. Ride in single file except when passing. Yield the right of way to other users on the trail before entering, and to slower moving users along the pathway.

Keep Pathways Clear

Move completely off the trail when stopping. There are benches provided for your convenience.
