

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 13**

Consolidated to May 21st, 1985

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe, Province of Alberta to authorize entering into an Agreement with the Province of Alberta for the upgrading and maintenance of a Public Works.

WHEREAS the Town of Lacombe Wolfe Creek Flood Control Project was carried out as a joint venture by the Province of Alberta and the Town of Lacombe;

AND WHEREAS it is now deemed expedient that a project identified in records of the Department of Environment as the Town of Lacombe Wolfe Creek Flood Control Upstream of Highway #12, located in Twp 40 – Rge 26 & 27 – W4th,

NOWHEREFORE pursuant to the authority conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act RSA 1980 as amended, the Council of the Town of Lacombe enacts:

THAT the Mayor and Town Manager by and they are hereby required to sign an Agreement (a copy of which is attached hereto as Schedule "A") on behalf of the Town of Lacombe with the Minister of Environment to enable the carrying out of this project.
