



20th Anniversary! Encore Art Sale & Celebration of Creative Expression April 26 & 27, 2019

STUDENT CALL-TO-ENTRY

The Encore Annual Sale and Celebration of Creative Expression encourages students ages 12 to 19 years to participate in visual arts. All young artists are welcome to submit one or two pieces of art for the Student Art Exhibition/Competition which runs in conjunction with the Art Exhibit & Sale each April. *Award presentations will be made at 4 pm on Saturday April 27th during the sale. Winners will be notified on Friday so that they and their families / friends can attend.*

Benefits to student artists:

- This event will provide exposure for you as an artist and an opportunity for you to display and/or sell your work
- You will gain experience in properly preparing your work for an art exhibition
- You get free access to the art sale!
- All the Student Art submissions will be juried for three \$250 Art Awards:
 - Dustin Peers Memorial Drawing Award
 - Jan Holoboff Jr. High School Art Award
 - Charlie Donald Memorial High School Art Award

Student artwork will be displayed at the discretion of the organizers. Photos of the works and the entry form are to be submitted by March 15, 2019 along with the student registration fee of \$5.

PREPARING FOR THE EVENT

Your artwork needs to be displayable:

- *All works should be framed including a wire hanger on the back, so that they can be hung properly.*
- Diptych, Triptych pieces are to be joined together so that they hang properly. Loose pieces rarely line up properly, and take away from the look and feel of the artwork and don't jury as well.
- You must have adequate hanging wire. Wire is best, if using anything else, please be sure it is securely attached so that it does not break or pull away from the frame (e.g. use commercial grade staples, not paper staples). Don't rely on the little saw tooth hooks that are used on pre-made frames from the Dollar Stores, as they pull out easily. When possible, screw in durable hooks on the sides of the frames and string a wire between them.
- If you are unsure about your frame, please speak with your teacher, or call Maureen at 403-782-1258 for help.

Submitting your artwork:

- Please print legibly on the entry form
- Complete your entry form in full including an e-mail address and phone number in case we have any questions, and so that you can be contacted Friday morning if you have won.
- Include your full mailing address, with the postal code. If your piece is selected as one of the award winners, and you are not able to be present to receive the award Saturday afternoon, we will mail it to you.

- Ensure your submissions have your name, grade, age, title of the piece, and the medium you used. If you are unsure what type of paint you used, please ask your teacher.
- If you would like to sell your artwork, include the price. If you don't want to sell it, please write NFS.
- Complete the artwork labels on this application form. Cut them off the application form and securely tape them to the back of your artwork so that we know who the artist is..
- The \$5 fee is due with your application.
- Photographs of your artwork are to be sent in with your application. If we receive more applications than what will fit in the student Art Gallery space, the Committee will review all photos and chose one piece from each student to go into the show. We will notify your teacher of the piece that has been accepted so that you can have it ready.
- The submission deadline is **March 15, 2019**.

Additional Information:

1. The organizing committee is not responsible for injuries, damage or losses to exhibitors or their goods.
2. Pieces will not be accepted until your \$5 payment and photos are received.
3. Student artwork can be dropped off at Lacombe City Hall the week prior to the event, or at the LMC on Thursday, April 25th, between 1 pm and 4:30 pm. Unfortunately we cannot accept artwork after this time.
4. All entries must be removed from the event between 5 & 6 PM, Saturday April 27th. Please ensure that your artwork is picked up and goes home at that time. You will not be able to remove your pieces from the student gallery until they have been accounted for by the Student Gallery Coordinator at 5pm on Saturday. Your patience is appreciated.
5. If you are able to help us hang student artwork on Thursday afternoon from 1 – 4:30 pm, we'd love to have you join us. It's a great opportunity to volunteer and learn a bit more about the art sale. E-mail Maureen at mmackenzie@lacombe.ca if you'd like to help.

The Art Sale assists in raising money for the Lacombe Art Endowment Fund, and 2018 marked another great year. Continuing arts education grants were awarded to Blair Regier (ballet), Harbour Lehocky (violin) and Phyllis Obst (ceramics) so they could continue their artistic passions. If you live in Lacombe, or Lacombe County, you can apply for this grant if you are taking additional arts based courses at a recognized school or training facility such as Red Deer College.
