A by-law of the Town of Lacombe requesting the removal of Video Lottery Terminals from the Town of Lacombe.

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Municipal Government Act S.A. 1994, c. M-26.1*, electors of the Town of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta concerned about the adverse effects of Video Lottery Terminals have petitioned the municipal Council to pass a bylaw requesting the minister responsible for the Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission to remove the existing Video Lottery Terminals from the Town of Lacombe;


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LACOMBE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA IN OPEN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Minister responsible for the Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission be requested to remove the existing Video Lottery Terminals from the Town of Lacombe.
2. The said Minister be advised that the Town of Lacombe further requests that the Municipality remain free of Video Lottery Terminals henceforward.
3. This By-law shall come into effect upon passage of final reading.


