



Engineers Stamp

The following list of components may require an Engineers Stamp for Building Permit approval.

- Preserved wood foundation
- Foundations due to bearing certificates
- Foundations for walkout basements
- Foundation due to wall width or height
- Foundations when backfill exceeds 7.5 ft
- Grade beams & piles not as per Standata
- Structural concrete (slabs, brackets etc)
- Retaining walls
- Engineered roof/floor systems due to complexity
- Columns, pads & beams point loading
- Flush connections for built up beams
- Wood joists over spanned by table limits
- Cantilevered load bearing joists
- Masonry supported on wood frame
- Concrete topping on wood floor system
- Modular frame construction (steel/concrete)
- Complex stick frame roofs
