

**TOWN OF LACOMBE  
BYLAW 17**

A bylaw to authorize the Municipal Council of the Town of Lacombe, Province of Alberta, to enter into agreements with Her Majesty, the Queen, in the right of Alberta (represented by the Minister of the Environment).

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, (as amended), the Council may pass a Bylaw authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by Council and the Province or its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and

WHEREAS under the Environment Grant Regulations, the Minister of the Environment may enter into an agreement with a local authority to provide for any work or undertakings, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lacombe has made application to the Minister of the Environment under the Alberta Municipal Water Supply and Sewage Treatment Grant program for financial assistance for a project relating to the installation of Water Supply Improvements in the Town of Lacombe.

NOW THEREFORE THE Municipal Council duly assembled enacts as follows:

That the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Lacombe be and is hereby empowered to execute agreements similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A", between the said Town and the Minister of the Environment relating to the Alberta Municipal Water Supply and Sewage Treatment Grant Program.
