

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 33**

A BYLAW OF THE Town of Lacombe, Province of Alberta, to authorize the Municipal Council to enter into Agreements with Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Alberta (represented by the Minister of the Environment).

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter 246 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980m, (as amended), the Council may pass a bylaw authorizing the making of an agreement with the Province of Alberta, or its agents, for the performance of any matter of thing considered by the Council and the Province of its agents to be a benefit to both parties; and

WHEREAS under Section 7 of the Land Surface Conservation and Reclamation Act, the Minister of the Environment may enter into an agreement with an owner to restrict the use of certain land;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Lacombe in Council assembled enacts as follows:

THAT the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Lacombe be and are hereby empowered to execute an agreement similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A", between the said Town and the Minister of the Environment relating to reclamation of certain lands described as follows:

Pt. SE ¼ 36-40-27-W4 – Containing twenty (20) acres more or less

READ a first time this 27th day of June, AD 1983.

READ a second time this 27th day of June, AD 1983.

READ a third time and passed this 27th day of June, AD 1983.
