## TOWN OF LACOMBE BYLAW 37

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway.

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe for the purpose of closing a portion of a public highway in accordance with Sections 180, and 183 of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statues of Alberta, 1980,

WHEREAS, the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel; and

WHEREAS, application has been made to Council to have the highway closed; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been mailed by registered mail to persons registered or assessed as owners of the land abutting that portion of the highway so proposed to be closed, at least two weeks before the date fixed for the passing of the Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, notice of intention of Council to a bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Globe on November 23 and November 30, 1983, the last of such publication being at least two weeks before the day fixed for the passing of he Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person prejudicially affected by the Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council, of the Town of Lacombe, does hereby close the following described highway:

"All that portion of street (55<sup>th</sup> – Carbert) on Plan 4487 MC, excepting thereout all mines and minerals", subject to rights of access granted by other legislation or regulations.

INTRODUCED and given first reading this 28<sup>th</sup> day of November, A.D. 1983.

GIVEN second reading this 12<sup>th</sup> day of December, A.D. 1983.

UPON UNANIMOUS CONSENT, GIVEN THIRD AND FINAL READING this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April, A.D. 1984.
