AUMA – Hazardous Waste Management

Council directed Administration to draft a letter to Ron Orr, MLA, regarding recycling regulations.

Planning & Development Services

Bylaw 432 (Heritage Designation - Cenotaph)

Council approved Bylaw 432, a bylaw to designate the site known as the Lacombe Cenotaph as a Municipal Historic Resource, after giving it second and third readings.

The Lacombe Cenotaph is located in Lest We Forget Park, at the corner of 50 Avenue and 53 Street in the heart of Lacombe's historic downtown. It was erected in 1924 as a memorial to honour the citizens of Lacombe who gave their lives in the Great War (1914-1918). Subsequent additions have been made to the Cenotaph to reflect the sacrifices of the Lacombe citizens during World War II, the Korean War, and the War in Afghanistan.

Bylaw 404.04 (Rezone Lots in Wes Jackson Subdivision and Election Signage)

Council held a Public Hearing for Bylaw 404.04, to rezone lands described as Lots 1. Plan 822 1257 from Light Industrial (I1) to Heavy Industrial (I2) and Closed Road 8251ET and 2401R to Light Industrial (I1). The bylaw also includes the addition of regulations for the usage of election signage. No one spoke for or against the proposed bylaw. Council subsequently passed a resolution to approve Bylaw 404.04 after giving it second and third readings as amended.

Lacombe Lake Drainage

Council authorized Administration to forward a letter to the Province of Alberta - Environment and Parks, requesting a review of the impact of the Town of Blackfalds Northwest Area Master Stormwater Management Plan on the City of Lacombe.

Council passed a resolution to accept the Main Street Improvements program update as information.

Council & Legislative

City of Red Deer – Vehicles for Hire

Council directed Administration to participate in the regional consultation process with the City of Red Deer and other central Alberta municipalities to inform any potential updates to bylaws that regulate vehicles for hire.
