

**TOWN OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 145**

A bylaw of the Town of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, to authorize the Municipal Council to enter into an agreement with Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Canada (As presented by the Minister of Public Works).

WHEREAS under the provisions of Section 116 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes a council may pass a bylaw authorizing the making of an agreement with the Government of Canada, or its agents, for the performance of any matter or thing considered by the council and the Government of Canada, or its agents, to be a benefit to both parties;

AND WHEREAS under the provision of Section 126 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, a Council may acquire land or any interest therein either inside or outside the municipality for any municipal purpose;

AND WHEREAS Agriculture Canada has declared as surplus to their needs certain property and has recommended to the Queen that this property be transferred to the Town of Lacombe to be utilized as a recreational area;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Lacombe is desirous of obtaining this property of utilization as recreational area;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Town of Lacombe in Council assembled enacts as follows:

THAT the Mayor and the Municipal Secretary of the Town of Lacombe be and are hereby empowered to execute an agreement similar to the form attached and marked Exhibit "A" between the said Town and Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Public Works.

READ a first time this 22nd day of October, A.D. 1990.

READ a second time this 22nd day of October, A.D. 1990.

READ a third time and passed this 22nd day of October A.D. 1990.
