

CITY OF LACOMBE
BYLAW 404
(North Parcels)

A Bylaw of the City of Lacombe in the Province of Alberta for the purpose of closing to public travel and create title to portions of a public roadway in accordance with Section 22 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26.

WHEREAS the lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel, and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Lacombe deems it expedient to provide for the purpose of closing to public travel certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and thereafter creating title to, and

WHEREAS Attachment 'A' which shows the location of the land described hereafter, is attached and forms part of this Bylaw, and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been published in the Lacombe Express on April 30, 2015 and May 7, 2015 in accordance with section 606 of the *Municipal Government Act*, and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on May 11, 2015 at 6:00 PM, to allow the general public to provide input into the proposed Bylaw amendments, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Lacombe, in the Province of Alberta, does hereby close to public travel and create title to the following described roadway, subject to the rights of access granted by other legislation:

1. Road Plan 1302 H.W.

"All that portion of Road as shown on Plan 1302 H.W. lying north of the north boundary of Lots 14 and 15, Block 33, Plan 1302 H.W., extending east into the government road allowance lying north of the north boundary of OT 30-40-26-W4M, containing 0.046 hectares more or less"

Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

2. Attachment "A" shall form part of this Bylaw.

3. This Bylaw shall come into effect upon final passage thereof.
